

GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATIONS

General Information:

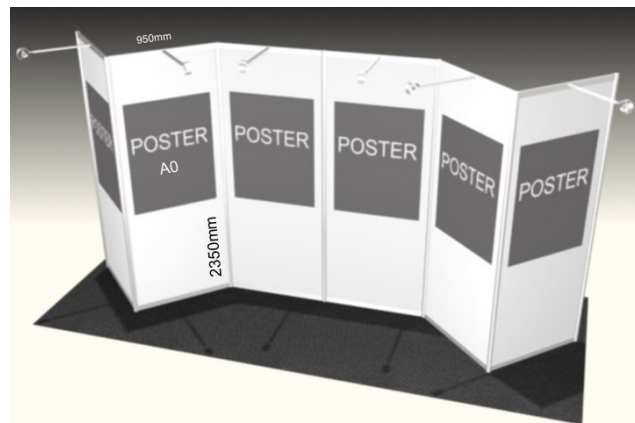
Presenters will be assigned to a session for each day of the conference which will be communicated in due course to all delegates. It is the responsibility of each delegate to ensure that they are familiar with these details to present their work at the appropriate session.

Poster Size:

The maximum page size for posters is A1 in portrait (84.1 cm high x 59.4 cm wide). Please do not exceed this size as your poster will not fit on the poster boards.

Poster Display:

Set up times and other procedures will be communicated to you in due course. However, on the day you will be allocated a number and provided with fixing material to display your poster on the appropriately numbered poster board. The poster boards will be similar to the following:



During the poster sessions, delegates are encouraged to please stand by their work for discussions and questions.

Poster Design:

To facilitate clarity and readability, we recommend that delegates use a simple font (i.e. Arial, Calibri, etc.) and a minimum point size for Titles: 50; Headings: 40 and Body text: 20.
